

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

SCREWING ABSORBERS

These instructions are for the following products: spectrum A10, spectrum A20, spectrum P816.



TOOLS

The following tools are needed for installation:

- ✓ Box Cutter/
utility knife
- ✓ Level
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Folding ruler or
tape measure
- ✓ Electric drill
- ✓ Drill bits
- ✓ (Electric) Screwdriver
- ✓ Anchors (6-8)
- ✓ Screws

Make sure to use the correct type of anchors for your mounting surface (drywall, masonry, concrete, etc.).

UNBOXING

Open the package carefully! Inserting sharp objects into the package can damage the absorber. Avoid using long, sharp tools for opening the package!



REMOVE PRODUCTS FROM PACKAGING

Carefully remove the products from the package and remove the protective film. Also remove the drilling template and mounting clips and set them aside.

DETERMINE THE MOUNTING POSITION

While determining the mounting positions, it helps to mark the walls and ceiling using a level and tape measure, in order to achieve even spacing in relation to corners and sound sources.





MARK AND DRILL HOLES USING THE TEMPLATE

Position and align the drilling template on the wall. Use the template to mark the drilling locations through the paper using a pencil. Then drill the holes.

INSERT ANCHORS, SCREW IN MOUNTING CLIPS

Insert anchors into the holes and use screws to securely attach the four mounting clips for installing the absorber.



ATTACH ABSORBER

Now you can attach the absorber to the mounting clips by pressing it evenly onto the four clips. Repeat this process for any additional absorbers. That's it!

TIP:

Make sure to examine the condition and load carrying capacity of the wall before installation.
