

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

SCREWING ABSORBERS

These instructions are for the following product: Print Panel 120



TOOLS

The following tools are needed for installation:

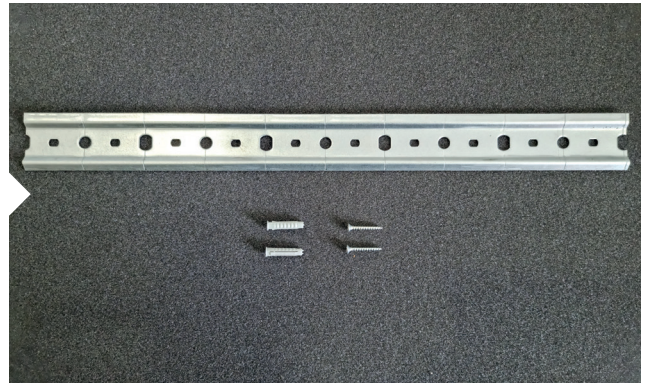
- ✓ Cutter
- ✓ Level
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Folding ruler / tape measure
- ✓ Drilling machine
- ✓ Drill bits
- ✓ (Electric) Screwdriver

Make sure to use the correct type of dowels for your mounting surface (drywall, masonry, concrete, etc.).

MOUNTING ACCESSORIES

The following mounting accessories are included for installation of the absorber:

- ✓ 1 × mounting rail
- ✓ 2 × dowel (6 mm)
- ✓ 2 × screw (3.5 mm × 30 mm)



UNBOXING

Open the package carefully! Inserting sharp objects into the package can damage the absorber. Avoid using long, sharp tools for opening the package!

Carefully remove the products from the package and read the mounting instructions carefully. Remove the mounting accessories and set them aside.

DETERMINE THE MOUNTING POSITION

While determining the mounting positions, it helps to mark the walls using a level and tape measure, in order to achieve even spacing in relation to corners and sound sources.

Use the small holes in the mounting rail to mark the distances of the drilling locations.





DRILL HOLES

Drill the holes at the markings using the drilling machine.

INSERT DOWELS

Insert the dowels into the drilled holes.



ATTACH THE MOUNTING RAIL

Place the mounting rail over the dowels and fasten it to the wall with two screws using an (electric) screwdriver.

ATTACH ABSORBER

Now you can attach the absorber to the screws.
Repeat this process for any additional absorbers.
That's it!



TIP:

Make sure to examine the condition and load carrying capacity of the wall before installation.
