DANGER!

Danger for children

NOTICE!

External power supply

The device is powered by an external power supply. Before connecting the external power supply, ensure that the input voltage (AC outlet) matches the voltage rating of the device and that the AC outlet is protected by a residual current circuit breaker. Failure to do so could result in damage to the device and possibly the user.

Unplug the external power supply before electrical storms occur and when the device is unused for long periods of time to reduce the risk of electric shock or fire.





NOTICE!

Risk of fire due to incorrect polarity

Incorrectly inserted batteries may destroy the device or the batteries.

NOTICE!

Possible damage by leaking batteries

Leaking batteries can cause permanent damage to the device.

3 Instructions for use

Unpack and carefully check that there is no transportation damage before using the unit. Keep the equipment packaging. To fully protect the device against vibration, dust and moisture during transportation or storage use the original packaging or your own packaging material suitable for transport or storage, respectively.


Handle the device with care.

Do not try to disassemble or repair the device yourself in the unlikely event that it does not work.

Do not use solvents such as alcohol to clean the device.



4 Components and functions



1	IN Input jack for standard ¼-inch guitar cable
2	LED lights when the effect pedal is used. When the LED is off or dim while the effect pedal is used, replace the battery.
3	Bypass pedal
4	OUT Output jack: Using a standard ¼-inch guitar cable you can plug in another pedal from this jack or plug directly into your amplifier
5	DC 9V Power adapter. When the power adapter is used, the battery supply is cut off auto- matically.
6	LOW adjusts the low frequencies.



7	MID
	adjusts the mid frequencies.
8	HIGH
	adjusts the high frequencies.
9	LEVEL
	adjusts the output level.
10	VOICE
	adjusts frequency response and distortion. In combination with DRIVE, it can simu- late many kinds of amplifiers.
11	DRIVE
	adjusts the degree of distortion.

Establish all connections as long as the unit is switched off. Use the shortest possible highquality cables for all connections.



Power supply	You can either use a 9 V battery or the DC 9 V connection for an external power supply. Before connecting, check for correct polarity.
	When you do not use the pedal unplug the instrument cable from the input jack. Otherwise, the battery will be discharged.
Changing the battery	To insert or change the battery, disconnect a possibly used power adapter from the mains socket. Turn the pedal over, press lightly on the battery compartment cover and slide it downwards in the direction of the arrow. Remove the back cover. Insert/replace the 9 V DC battery paying attention to the polarity markings and place the cover again into its original position until it locks.
