2 Safety instructions

Intended use

This stage platform system is used for modular and flexible construction of stages in different compilations. Use the product only as described in this user manual. Any other use or use under other operating conditions is considered to be improper and may result in personal injury or property damage. No liability will be assumed for damages resulting from improper use.

This device may be used only by persons with sufficient physical, sensorial, and intellectual abilities and having corresponding knowledge and experience. Other persons may use this device only if they are supervised or instructed by a person who is responsible for their safety.

Safety



Danger for children

Ensure that plastic bags, packaging, etc. are properly disposed of and are not in the reach of babies and young children. Choking hazard! Ensure that children do not detach any small parts (e.g. knobs or the like) from the product. They could swallow the pieces and choke! Never let children play unattended with the product.

Risk of fracture in case of overload

When the maximum load capacity is exceeded platforms can break and cause personal injury and property damage. Observe the maximum load capacity.



Danger of tipping on unsuitable surface

When the platform is installed on soft or uneven ground the platform may tip over and cause personal injuries and property damage. Install the platform only on even and solid surfaces.



Risk of injury due to heavy weight

Due to the heavy weight of the stage platform, at least two persons are required for transport and assembly.



3 Features

The stage platform system can be assembled from the following components:

- Stage platform (of different sizes and shapes) for indoor and outdoor use
- Plug-in feet (of different sizes and versions)
- Railings (of different sizes and versions to match the stage platforms and stairs)
- Modular or variable stairs
- Mounting elements and connectors



4 Installation

4.1 Setting up stage platforms

$\stackrel{\circ}{\amalg}$ Comply with regulations

When installing and operating, make sure to follow the standards and regulations that apply in your country. In Germany: DGUV 17, DGUV 18, DGUV Regel 115-002 'Veranstaltungs- und Produktionsstätten für szenische Darstellung' (Staging and Production Facilities for the Entertainment Industry).



Setting up stage platforms



1. Insert the plug-in feet into the provided recess on the bottom of the stage platform.



2. Fix the plug-in feet with the hand screws to the stage platform.

For a height of more than 100 cm, connecting struts must be mounted diagonally for the reasons of additional safety!

The load capacity of 750 kg/m² refers to the stage platforms of the standard formats with the dimensions 1000 mm \times 1000 mm \times 90 mm and 2000 mm \times 1000 mm \times 90 mm. Special formats must be used as decorative elements and installed and carried in relation with the standard formats.

All standard formats with the dimensions 1000 mm \times 1000 mm \times 90 mm and 2000 mm \times 1000 mm \times 90 mm have a TÜV certificate.

4.2 Fixing the stage platforms and the plug-in feet

If you build up several stage platforms connect them to each other with the provided connectors and clamps as illustrated.



1. Insert the nuts (1) into the guide rails on the insides of the stage platforms to be connected and fix the stage platforms with the frame connectors (2) to the bottom side of the guide rails.



2. Insert the quick connectors (3) into the profile of the guide rails on the outsides of the stage platforms to be connected and tighten the screws of the quick connectors using an Allen key.





3. Fix two plug-in feet standing side by side with a dual plug-in feet connector (4) and tighten the wing screws.



4. Fix four plug-in feet standing side by side with a quadruple plug-in feet connector (5) and tighten the wing screws.

4.3 Attaching the railings



1. Mount the railing holders to the corresponding locations on the stage platform and tighten the screws using an Allen key.



- **2.** Insert the railing all the way into the round tubes of the railing holders and tighten the hand screws of the railing holders.
- **3.** If more railings are required, attach them to the stage platforms first.



- **4.** Fix two railings standing side by side with a connecting clamp and tighten the hand screw.
- **5.** Check the railings for firm fit.

4.4 Attaching the stairs



The following instructions describe the mounting of the the Stairville Tour Stage Vario stairs.

1. Insert the mounting element into the guide rails of the stage platform and place the stairs holder on the stage platform.



- 2. Connect the mounting element to the stairs holder and hand-tighten the screws using an Allen key.
- **3.** Slide the stairs to the desired position and tighten the screws using an Allen key.





- **4.** Mount the railing holders to the corresponding locations on the stairs and tighten the screws using an Allen key.
- **5.** Insert the railing all the way into the round tubes of the railing holders and tighten the hand screws of the railing holders.
- **6.** Check the railings for firm fit.
